Candidates must be returning to school in September and be between the ages of 15-29.

Background in the areas of Education, Biology, Forestry, Fish and Wildlife, Environmental Programs, or Outdoor Leadership preferred.

Successful applicants will be required to provide a current Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sectors Screening.

1. The **Environmental Education Technician** will be seasonally employed by Conservation Sudbury. The primary work site will be the Lake Laurentian Conservation Area on South Bay Road, Sudbury.
2. The maximum work period will be eighteen (18) weeks. The maximum work period will be from May 4, 2020 to September 4, 2020, inclusive.
3. The **Environmental Education Technician** will be paid \$14.10 per hour with Statutory Benefits only. Four percent (4%) Vacation Pay will also be provided in each pay. No other employment benefits are provided. Full WSIB coverage is provided.
